With reference to your representation cited, it is informed that, the State Election Commission is taking necessary action to incorporate all the changes made in the Assembly Constituency Electoral Rolls 2018 (ACERs) in to the Grama Panchayat Electoral Rolls (GPERs) 2018.

As stipulated under section 11 of Panchayat Raj Act, and rules issued thereunder, the latest published Assembly electoral rolls are adopted for preparation and publication of ward wise and Gram Panchayat wise electoral rolls. Accordingly the Commission published GPERs 2018 on 17.05.2018 by adopting assembly electoral rolls published on 24.3.2018.

The Commission issued instructions to the District Panchayat Officers to update the GPERs 2018 by adopting the assembly mother rolls (01.09.2018) along with supplements published on 12.10.2018 and 19.11.2018. This integrated supplement shall be treated as supplement I to the GPERs 2018.

As envisaged in Section 11 of Telangana Panchayat Raj Act and rules issued there under, after publication of GPERs, any additions, deletions made in the ACERs upto the date of election notification are carried in the concerned GPERs.

Keeping in view of the above Act provision, the Commission requested the Chief Electoral Officer and District Collectors to issue instructions to the Assembly constituency Electoral Registration Officers to continue continuous updation of process of electoral rolls duly disposing the claims and objections filed with EROs within stipulated time duly following the procedure till the date of election notification to be issued by the State Election Commission so as to carry the same in the GPERs up to the date of Gram Panchayats election notification.

The Chief Electoral Officer, Telangana vide reference 2nd cited advised all the District Election Officers (Except Hyderabad) that in view of continuous updation, to dispose of all the claims and objections with effect from 10.11.2018 for conduct of Gram Panchayat elections and furnish the same as Supplement - II to DPOs. The SEC has already advised the District Collectors / District Election Officers & District Panchayat Officers to consider this and incorporate the same as Supplement - II to the GPERs 2018 published on 17.05.2018.
