**NOTIFICATION**

**No.480/TSEC-PR/2022**

**Dated:20.05.2022**

Whereas, in reference No. 09/TSEC-PR/2022, dated: 29.03.2022 the State Election Commission issued a Notification for preparation and publication of Ward wise Electoral rolls of Gram Panchayats having ordinary and casual vacancies in Gram Panchayats and also of Gram Panchayats having casual and ordinary vacancies of MPTCs and ZPTC including casual vacancies in the office of Ward Members of Ward No.1, 4 and 6 of Prathapnagar Gram Panchayat of Gundlapally Mandal in Nalgonda district.

And whereas, after publication of final ward wise electoral rolls of Prathapnagar Gram Panchayat on 21.04.2022, the DPO Nalgonda sent a letter Lr.No.934/2022-E(Pts), dated 09.05.2022 to the Commission stating that, the MPDO, Gundlapally has reported him that, after final publication of electoral rolls of Prathapnagar GP in Gundlapally mandal, a complaint was received from the Sarpanch, Prathapnagar Gram Panchayat wherein it is alleged that, some voters of ward no.7 were included in ward no. 4 and requested to modify the voters from 4<sup>th</sup> ward to 7<sup>th</sup> ward of Prathapnagar GP.

And whereas, the State Election Commission, vide letter no. 480/TSEC-PR/2022, dated: 11.05.2022 requested the Collector & District Election Authority, Nalgonda to inquire into the matter and send a detailed factual report to the State Election Commission.

And whereas, vide letter no. 934/2022-E (Pts), dt.13.05.2022, the C&DEA, Nalgonda, sent report to the Commission indicating the following flaws crept in the mapping of Assembly electoral rolls to Prathapnagar GP wards published on 21.04.2022.

- 1) 64 voters were mapped to Ward No. 1 and still 8 voters are to be mapped to it from ACERs.
- 2) 92 voters were mapped to Ward No. 4. From these mapped 92 voters, 10 voters are to be deleted and 8 voters are to be mapped to 7<sup>th</sup> Ward and 2 voters to 5<sup>th</sup> Ward.
- 3) 64 voters were mapped to Ward No. 6 and still 14 voters are to be mapped to it from ACERs.

And whereas, the Commission examined the report of the Collector and District Election Authority Nalgonda and came to conclusion that, discrepancies were occurred in the mapping of Assembly electoral rolls to GP Wards. Voters of a ward were mapped to another ward and mapping of voters from Assembly electoral rolls is still incomplete.

And whereas, so as to rectify discrepancies in the electoral rolls, the State Election Commission decided to nullify the electoral rolls published on 21.04.2022 and issue notification for preparation and publication of Ward Wise photo electoral rolls a fresh duly carrying out the discrepancies.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred Article 243-K of the Constitution of India and all other powers here unto enabling, the State Election Commission, hereby, nullifies the electoral rolls published on 21.04.2022 in respect of Prathapnagar Gram Panchayat and directs the District Panchayat Officer, Nalgonda district to Prepare and Publish Ward Wise Photo Electoral Rolls of **Prathapnagar Gram Panchayat, Gundlapally Mandal Praja Parishad of Nalgonda District** on **28.05.2022** (having casual vacancies in the office of Ward Members of 1<sup>st</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Wards) by adopting the latest ACERs published on 05.01.2022 w.r.t. 01.01.2022 as the qualifying date and duly following the ward division/jurisdiction carved out in Gram Panchayat Electoral Rolls (GPERs) -2018 that were used for the Gram Panchayat Elections, 2019 as per schedule given below, duly indicating the Ward division as per the procedure mentioned in Section 11 (4) of the Telangana Panchayat Raj Act, 2018 in **Form – I**.

As stipulated under Section 11(1) of Telangana Panchayat Raj Act, 2018 after final publication of Gram Panchayat Photo Electoral Rolls on **28.05.2022**, any inclusions, deletions or corrections if any ordered in the Assembly Electoral Rolls by the Electoral Registration Officer of the Assembly Constituency concerned under

continuous updation under Section 22 or 23 of RP Act, 1950 from 06.01.2022 **upto the date of Election Notification**, shall be obtained by the District Panchayat Officer from the ERO concerned and shall be carried out in the concerned wards of the Gram Panchayat Electoral Rolls till the date of issue of election notification by the State Election Commission.

The MPDO and Asst. District Election Authority shall personally monitor the mapping of Assembly Electoral rolls to GP Wards and ensure all the voters are mapped without flaws.
