NOTIFICATION

No.64/TSEC-PR/2019

Dated:06.01.2019

Whereas, in the reference No. 363/TSEC-PR/2018, dated 01.01.2019, the State Election Commission issued notification for conduct of Ordinary Elections to Gram Panchayats in three phases in the State in which Masaipet Gram Panchayat of Yadagirigutta Mandal in Yadadri Bhongir District was also notified for election in phase-I.

And whereas, after issue of Election Notification, it came to the notice of the State Election Commission that, in I.A No. 1 of 2018 in W.P. No. 46750 of 2018, dated 26.12.2018, "the Hon'ble High Court directed the State Election Commission not to notify the Panchayat Raj Elections to Masaipet village, Yadagirigutta Mandal, Nalgonda District till 31.12.2018 without rectifying the voters list in accordance with the rules mentioned above".

And Whereas, in I.A No. 1 of 2018 in W.P. No. 46750 of 2018, the Hon'ble High court passed orders on 4.1.2019 that,-

There shall be an interim direction to the Commission, respondent No. 3 herein, to exercise its power of superintendence in relation to the electoral roll drawn up by the District Panchayat Officer, Nalgonda District, for Masaipet Village and take remedial measures for delineating the ward wise voters on geographical basis as required under the rules. It would also be open to the Commission to reschedule the election for Masaipet village from Phase-I to a later phase in the event it is not in a position to complete the exercise as directed supra within a reasonable time.

And Whereas, in the reference Roc.No. 01/2019-A(Pts), dated 05.1.2019, the District Collector, (Panchayat wing) and District Election Authority, Yadadri Bhongir District requested the State Election Commission to reschedule the election to Masaipet

Gram Panchayat of Yadagirigutta Mandal from Phase-I to Phase-III so as to verify and to re- arrange the ward wise Gram Panchayat electoral roll as per the Hon'ble High Court directions.

And Whereas, the State Election Commission examined the matter and decided to reschedule the election of Masaipet Gram Panchayat of Yadagirigutta Mandal in Yadadri Bhongir district from Phase-I to Phase-III with direction to the District Election Authority to rectify the discrepancies in the electoral rolls of the Masaipet Gram Panchayat as per the directions of the Hon'ble High Court duly following the procedure.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 243-K of the Constitution of the India, and Rule 6 of the Rules relating to the Telangana Panchayat Raj (conduct of elections of Members and Sarpanch of Gram Panchayats, Members of Mandal Praja Parishads and Members of Zilla Praja Parishads) Rules, 2018 and in compliance of the orders of the Hon'ble High Court, the State Election Commission, hereby, reschedules the election schedule of Masaipet Gram Panchayat of Yadagirigutta Mandal in Yadadri Bhongir district from Phase-I to Phase-III indicated in the Annexure-II and conduct elections as per the election schedule for phase-III indicated in the Annexure-I appended to the notification no. 363/TSEC-PR/2018, dated 01.01.2019.
